91 year old “Breaks the Ground” for new Allenton Library, Derby

Local construction company, A&S Enterprises has marked the start of the Allenton Library with a 91 year old behind the controls of a digger. The ground breaking ceremony was carried out by Grace Davies who was invited to do the honours as she was one of the local residents consulted on the project. Originally Grace was going to use a spade but she was delighted to get behind the controls.



The £585,000 building project was won in open competition by A & S Enterprises Ltd and is their latest construction contract for Derby City Council. The project involves the conversion and extension of the former Allenton Park Infants School into a new Library and will be completed next May.

Commenting on the new contract Andy Sulin, Director said “We are pleased to be entrusted with our third construction project for Derby City Council in a short space of time. This latest project adds to our diverse portfolio of projects going forwards into 2009”.

Other projects for Derby City Council include Moor Lane School Pavilion and MUGA and the Carlton Day Nursery.
